SUBJECT: December 2025 Monthly Report

The WMTFD ended 2025 with 1,232 calls for service. This is a 3.75% decrease in call volume from 2024. Our slowest month for call volume was February with 78 calls for service and our busiest month for calls for service was July with 120 calls for service. Please take some time to read the annual report that will be published later this month that showcases all aspects of the department during 2025.

I am extremely proud of the job that the members have done this past year and couldn't have asked for a better team.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE CONTINUED

- There was a total of 641 personnel that responded to the incidents with an average of 8.01 per incident. (Average does not include Duty Officer & Fire Police Only Calls).
- Year to date, a total of 6,760 personnel responded to the incidents.
- We are at a 3.75% decrease in call volume from this time last year.

DEPARTMENT NEWS

- The new Heavy Rescue that was ordered in June of 2023 has finally hit the production line. Several production pictures have been sent to the Supervisors as well as posted on social media. As of this report the cab construction is complete and has been staged for painting prep. We will continue to provide updates as the construction process progresses.
- We have started putting together requirements and policies for the hiring of our part-time firefighters. I will provide copies of all documents once they are drafted for the board's review prior to starting the application process.

RECRUITMENT & RETENTION

During the January meeting we welcomed four (4) new members into the department:

- **Wyatt Zech** – Wyatt is the son of Toby Zech who recently became a member of the department several months ago. Wyatt heard a lot of positives from his dad and wanted to give the fire service a try.
- **Jade Smith** – Jade is the wife of Firefighter Matt Smith and was a firefighter at a previous department. She wants to get back into firefighting and since they recently moved into the Township she wanted to join the WMTFD.
- **Kendal Smith** – is the daughter of Firefighter Matt Smith and would like to join the WMTFD as a Junior Firefighter.

We ended the year bringing in 16 new members (11 Operational and 5 Social). Also during the year we lost 11 members (7 Operational and 4 Social). This leaves us with a net gain of 5 for 2025.
