- A. <u>RESOLUTION 23-15 HONORING SUPERVISOR DAVE MARKEL</u>: Motion to approve, revise, table or deny Resolution 23-15, recognizing Supervisor Dave Markel for his twenty-three (23) years of outstanding service to the residents of West Manchester Township as Township Supervisor.
- B. <u>APPOINTMENT OF SUPERVISOR</u>: Discussion and motion on appointment of Township Supervisor to serve the remainder of Dave Markel's term, which will begin immediately and end on December 31st, 2025. Six residents applied for this vacancy and were all interviewed by the current Board.
