NEW BUSINESS:

A. ORDINANCE 25-05 HANDICAP PARKING REQUEST: Motion to approve Ordinance 25-05, a handicap parking request for 1018 West Locust Street. The police department has made a recommendation to approve this, and the Ordinance has been properly advertised.

B. ORDINANCE 25-06 ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT REQUEST (DATA CENTERS): Motion to approve Ordinance 25-06, amending the code of West

Manchester Township and the "Zoning Map of West Manchester Township" to include within the data center overlay zone. This would pertain to the parcels located to the North of West Market Street (SR 0030) and to the South of South Salem Church Road. Vice Chairman Ruman addressed the residents to thank them for their comments and questions. He informed them that this was only the first step, and that many more public meetings will occur in the future for the land development plans, etc. Chairman Harlacher echoed his comment and reiterated that the current land owner wishes to sell the land no matter what comes in there. Supervisor Margetas also thanked the residents for attending.

C. 2298 HEATHER ROAD STORMWATER EASEMENT ENCROACHMENT

REQUEST: Motion to table a request from Angela Lawson of 2298 Heather Road to encroach into the 10' wide stormwater easement along the side property line for the installation of a shed on a stone pad. The proposed encroachment would be for one corner of the shed pad at approximately 30 square feet into the stormwater easement. If the encroachment is authorized by the Board of Supervisors, the property owner must sign an easement agreement to be recorded at the Recorder of Deeds' office memorializing the agreement prior to obtaining a permit for the shed and stone pad installation.

Vice Chairman Ruman acknowledged Mr. Drais's concerns for the contract but informed the residents that the SPCA does do a lot for the animals and at this time the Township does not have any other option for animal housing in York County.

amount of \$1,610,600.00 for the final land development plan and to use Picea Abies and Picea Glauca in addition to the existing trees for screening at the west edge of the property adjacent to the residential zone. Dawood Engineers has reviewed both requests and recommends the amount of \$1,610,600.00.
