Police Chief's Report for April 2024

April 25, 2024

Dear Board of Supervisors, Manager and staff,

For the month of March, the officers handled 477 incidents as well as 61 vehicle crashes. Officers conducted over 436 traffic stops and issued 168 traffic citations. The department made 11 felony arrests, 30 misdemeanor arrests, 18 summary non-traffic arrest and 10 juvenile petitions were also filed.

On Wednesday March 27th there was a fatal crash on Rt. 74 in the area of Kane Road. The vehicles collided head on and there multiple injuries and one death as a result of the crash. Officers investigated that crash and reconstructed the scene. The incident is still being investigated.

Officer Erik Potter is currently on Field Training but he is progressing very well and will be on his own soon. In the beginning of April, he will be released and patrolling on his own. Erik will be a replacement for Officer Keller who retired last month. Erik is doing extremely well and has been a very good addition to the department patrol division.

Officer Laron Woody is on training for the Army Reserve. He has been on that training since the beginning of the year. He will be returning to duty at the end of May.

The department has transitioned into carrying the new version of Taser called the Taser ten. The training and implementation have been occurring during our training on force training over the last two months. Once everyone is trained on the Taser ten, the department will be fully deployed, and we can benefit from the newest technology that Taser has to offer.

CI Division Report for April 2024 Board Meeting

3/20/2024 through 4/17/2024

Since March 20, 2024, WMTPD Criminal Investigations has taken on 11 new case assignments: 1 PICS investigation, 7 ChildLine Referrals for alleged physical or sexual abuse of children (or general child endangerment), a forgery case, a suspicious death, and an allegation of sexual assault/solicitation of prostitution involving a local massage business.

During the same time frame, our office has formally closed out 7 investigations: the PICS case listed above, 4 investigations into physical or sexual abuse of children, the sexual assault/prostitution listed above, and a theft of tires listed in last month's report.

In addition to the above, members of the Detective Unit were called upon on two separate occasions to assist with investigations into fatal crashes within the Township; one in the 1900 block of Carlisle Rd and the other at the intersection of Route 30 and Kenneth Rd.
