### **Police Chief's Report for April 2025**

April 24, 2025

Dear Board of Supervisors, Manager and staff,


For the month of March, the officers handled 478 incidents as well as 65 vehicle crashes. Officers conducted over 419 traffic stops and issued 142 traffic citations. The department made 13 felony arrests, 47 misdemeanor arrests, 13 summary non-traffic arrests and 7 juvenile petitions were also filed.

The Department received an appreciation plaque from the United States Secret Service for our work assisting them with the event at Fairgrounds with the political event where Governor Tim Waltz of Minnesota who was the vice-presidential candidate for the Democratic Party in the 2024 Election cycle. We were afforded very short notice for the request, we provided a large number of police officers who stood guard for an entire day for this event, and we were compensated zero dollars for this request and commitment. We have recently researched and explored an MOU with the US Secret Service where we would receive reimbursement for our expenses in the future for these events. This is yet another example of the benefit of working with our federal partners and allowing our taxpayers to get some relief when we incur expenses assisting other agencies. This is another example of our agency utilizing federal funding to offset our costs for events such as this.

**CI Division Report for April 2026 Board Meeting**

**3/19/2026 through 4/16/2026**

Since March 19, 2026, WMTPD Criminal Investigations has taken on 14 new case assignments: 6 ChildLine Referral cases for alleged sexual or physical assaults against children/juveniles or general child endangerment, 2 assists to other police departments with investigations into alleged possession/distribution of Child Sexual Assault Material (CSAM), 2 additional investigations into alleged possession/distribution of CSAM here in the Township, a theft of materials from a Met-Ed substation, an evidence assist dealing with a large number of firearms and ammunition, a fugitive case (escapee from a juvenile detention facility) from Allegheny County harboring a runaway from Dauphin County, and a weapons possession case involving the same juvenile fugitive from Allegheny County.

During the same time frame, our office has formally closed out 6 cases: 2 of the ChildLine Referrals listed above for sexual assault cases with, one of the two CSAM assists from outside our area, one of the two CSAM cases here in the Township, the fugitive from Allegheny County listed above (weapons possession charge stemming from the same incident still pending), and a sexual assault of a child from February of this year.
