Police Chief's Report for August 2023

August 24th 2023

Dear Board of Supervisors, Manager and staff,

For the month of May, the officers handled 443 incidents as well as 60 vehicle crashes. Officers conducted over 328 traffic stops and issued 109 traffic citations. The department made 9 felony arrests, 26 misdemeanor arrests, 41 summary non-traffic arrests and 8 juvenile petitions were filed.

The 2023 Greater York State Fair started on July 21st and ended on July 30th. We had the event properly staffed by our officers as well as law enforcement professionals from the York County Sheriff's Office, Pennsylvania State Police, York County Probation, York Fair Police and others. We felt that the week was a success with a reasonable amount of issues inside the fairgrounds. Police presence was obviously a deterrent and we felt that it contributed to the low number of police related issues during the event.

Our 2023 National Night Out was a huge success. The weather contributed to a large turnout and we were more than prepared for the large crowd this year. We handed out tons of food and provided a lot of entertainment. Our staff handed out food, managed the event and met with the public. We used this event to meet with the residents that came out. It was really a team effort but three officers in particular need to be recognized. Officer Brad Cleck, Officer Colin Harner and Officer David Keller really did a great job for the event. We also created a large number of child ID cards for


parents of children that requested one from our staff. The same ID cards were created at the York Fair on one of the days during Fair Week.

CI Division Report for August 2023 Board Meeting

7/20/2023 through 8/17/2023

Since July 20, 2023, WMTPD Criminal Investigations has taken on 9 new case assignments: 6 PICS cases, 2 ChildLine Referrals for physical or sexual abuse of children, and a Bad Check case that was forwarded from the DA's Office.

During the same time frame, our office has formally closed out 10 investigations – the Bad Check case listed above, 2 PICS cases, 5 ChildLine cases for child abuse (4 sexual, 1 physical, and 1 general endangering), a rape case involving an adult victim, and a sexual exploitation case.

Additionally, Investigative Grand Jury proceedings continue for the May 2022 homicide at the York Auto Spa car wash and trial preparations continue for the December 2019 homicide at Regal Cinemas.

As a final note, it is worth pointing out that all of the above continues to be done with the CI Division operating at 75% strength, as one of our Detectives has been assigned full time to the accreditation process since February and is no longer handling an active case load.
