Police Chief's Report for January 2024

January 25th, 2024

Dear Board of Supervisors, Manager and staff,

For the month of January, the officers handled 505 incidents as well as 70 vehicle crashes. Officers conducted over 228 traffic stops and issued 79 traffic citations. The department made 16 felony arrests, 36 misdemeanor arrests, 24 summary non-traffic arrest and 9 juvenile petitions were also filed.

Officers participated in several events in December related to Christmas and we provided gifts for over 80 kids this year. We worked with our partners from West York School District, Northshore Friends and Walmart along with some other private donors. We held our annual shop with a cop event at Walmart and we delivered gifts to families with the help of the Fire Department and West York Borough Police Department for our Secret Santa Program. Both events were well received, and it was great working with all our partners to help out some well deserving kids this year.

Officer Erik Potter has started his filed training program with the department and is fitting in very well. Erik will be a great addition to the department and I am looking forward to seeing him progress through the FTO process.

The storage system for our records room is now completed and we will be moving all the records back onto the shelves soon. This equipment will double our space and hopefully take us into the next decade with usable and valuable storage for

our employees. Previously to this equipment, the secretarial staff would use small step stools and carry heavy banker boxes down from unsafe heights. Now this will allow access to thousands of records and let the staff do so in a safe and easy manner.

CI Division Report for January 2024 Board Meeting

12/8/2023 through 1/18/2024

Since December 8, 2023, WMTPD Criminal Investigations has taken on 8 new case assignments: 1 PICS investigation, 4 Referrals for alleged physical or sexual abuse of children, a sexual assault involving an adult victim, a bank fraud case, and a Felony Retail Theft involving an organized ring out of Romania.

During the same time frame, our office has formally closed out 7 investigations: 2 PICS cases, the bank fraud and felony retail theft listed above, a contractor fraud case listed in last month's board report, a report of physical abuse of a child, and an investigation into the rape of a minor from back in September of 2023.

In addition to the above, it is worth noting that the CID was called upon to assist with multiple open investigations that were never formally assigned to or taken over by a Detective due to one of our officers going on an extended leave for a military commitment.
