Police Chief's Report for January 2026

January 23, 2026

Dear Board of Supervisors, Manager and staff,

For the month of December 2025, the officers handled 373 incidents as well as 76 vehicle crashes. Officers conducted over 235 traffic stops and issued 94 traffic citations. The department made 8 felony arrests, 30 misdemeanor arrests, 12 summary non-traffic arrests and 9 juvenile petitions were also filed.

Our shop with a cop program was a big success this year. We partnered with Walmart and West York School District to allow our families to shop for Christmas with our officers. The turnout was great and the students, all from West York School District. Received gift cards to shop with their families. This program has been one of the many platforms we use to conduct community policing. The program has allowed us to help approximately 400 kids since the beginning.


