Police Chief's Report for July 2026

July 23rd, 2026

Dear Board of Supervisors, Manager and staff,

For the month of July, the officers handled 480 incidents as well as 69 vehicle crashes. Officers conducted 470 traffic stops and issued 257 traffic citations. The department made 9 felony arrests, 42 misdemeanor arrests, 17 summary non-traffic arrests and 7 juvenile petitions were filed.

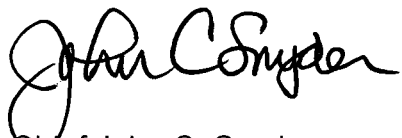

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CI Division Report for July 2026 Board Meeting

6/18/2026 through 7/16/2026

Since June 18, 2026, WMTDP Criminal Investigations has taken on 10 new case assignments: 1 PICS investigation, 1 ChildLine Referral case for alleged abuse/neglect of a child, an investigation into alleged possession/distribution of Child Sexual Abuse Material, an alleged rape of a child at a hotel in the Township, a report of an attempted luring of a child into a vehicle, a report of ideological terroristic threats against a local mosque (actually located in York City), a death investigation involving a 6-week-old infant, an investigation into the theft of an antique firearm from a residence, a Megan's Law Offender community notification, and an investigation into an alleged Megan's Law reporting violation.

During the same time frame, our office has formally closed out 11 cases: the PICS case listed above, the above-listed allegation of possession of Child Sexual Abuse Material, both of the above-listed investigations referred by the Megan's Law Unit, a rape investigation that was initiated back in February of this year, an investigation into child abuse/endangerment from the end of April, a theft/access device fraud case reported in April, and the 4 burglaries of the residences affected by fire on Stoverstown Rd in mid-May.
