**Police Chief's Report for June 2022**

June 23, 2022

Dear Board of Supervisors, Manager and staff,

For the month of May, the officers handled 385 incidents as well as 45 vehicle crashes. Officers conducted over 540 traffic stops and issues 274 traffic citations. The department made 11 felony arrests, 14 misdemeanor arrests, 23 summary non-traffic arrest and 9 juvenile petitions were also filed.

One of the issues that will impact the police department is York County emergency department's radio and communications equipment is slated to be replaced. Unfortunately, the equipment will no longer be supported by Harris Communications and we will need to start to replace our mobile radios and portable radios in the next few years. We are searching for available grants, but it will be tough to acquire those for the amount of funds necessary to replace the equipment. I will start to explore multiple options for equipment replacement with the intent to ease the cost over time if possible.

The department held a planning meeting for the York Interstate Fair and we had a great amount of participation from a number of law enforcement entities and others. We are very confident with the planning process and that the event this year will be well staffed and well attended by our law enforcement partners. Brian Blair, from the Fair, has been a great partner with us and will also be involved with the planning process.

**CI Division Report for June 2022 Board Meeting**

**05/17/2022 through 06/16/2022**

Since May 17, 2022, WMTPD Criminal Investigations has taken on 11 new case assignments: 3 PICS cases, 5 Child Line Referrals for physical or sexual abuse of children, a check fraud case, a robbery of a convenience store, and most notably the May 20<sup>th</sup> homicide (shooting) at the car wash on York Crossing Dr.

During the same time frame, our office has formally closed out 8 investigations: 2 of the 3 PICS cases listed above, 5 child abuse cases (both physical and sexual in nature), and the PFAD case listed in last month's report for the relinquishment of firearms relative to a Protection From Abuse Order. Investigation continues into the shooting at the car wash and all other listed cases. Additionally, active trial preparation is under way for the 2019 homicide at Regal Cinemas and new leads are being investigated relative to a 2017 homicide near the intersection of Hokes Mill Rd and Old Salem Rd.
