#### Police Chief's Report for June 2025

June 26th 2025

Dear Board of Supervisors, Manager and staff,

For the month of May, the officers handled 513 incidents as well as 65 vehicle crashes. Officers conducted over 296 traffic stops and issued 117 traffic citations. The department made 6 felony arrests, 38 misdemeanor arrests, 23 summary non-traffic arrest and 13 juvenile petitions were also filed.

Our officers and staff worked the event at the Fairgrounds called Rock the Country with over 25000 attendees for two evenings and the event included campers and RV vehicles in attendance. This was the first year for this event and it all went very smooth for the first time around. Much of the responsibility fell on Lt. Hanuska for the planning and staffing for the event and thanks to his efforts and our officers it was a very successful and relatively low problem weekend.

Officer Zak Werner has started working for the department and is on field training. He has several years of experience and will be working towards a successful completion of field training and becoming part of the patrol division.

Officer Andrew Shaffer will graduate from the academy on June 23<sup>rd</sup>. Officer Shaffer will then start his career and begin field training with the department to fill the open position in the patrol division.

## CI Division Report for June 2025 Board Meeting 5/15/2025 through 6/19/2025

Since May 15, 2025, WMTPD Criminal Investigations has taken on 12 new case assignments: 4 PICS cases, 3 bad check cases, 2 ChildLine Referral cases for alleged assaults of children or general child endangerment, a Statutory Sexual Assault claim, a theft/fraud report, and an investigation into alleged possession and/or distribution of Child Sexual Assault Material.

During the same time frame, our office has formally closed out 14 cases: 3 PICS cases, 2 bad check cases, 6 ChildLine Referral cases for suspected abuse/endangerment of children, 2 statutory sexual assault cases (the one listed above and one listed in last month's report), and a suspicious death from the end of April, which was ultimately ruled a suicide.
