Police Chief's Report for June 2026

June 25, 2026

Dear Board of Supervisors, Manager and staff,

For the month of May, the officers handled 545 incidents as well as 63 vehicle crashes. Officers conducted over 364 traffic stops and issued 176 traffic citations. The department made 10 felony arrests, 46 misdemeanor arrests, 20 summary non-traffic arrests and 18 juvenile petitions were also filed.


The department held a planning meeting for the York Interstate Fair and we had a great amount of participation from a number of law enforcement entities and others. We are very confident with the planning process and that the event this year will be well staffed and well attended by our law enforcement partners. During the meeting the plans were discussed and laid out expectations and plans for the Fair this year. We will be assisted by several law enforcement partners again including the Fair Police.

The department had our new in-car cameras and body cameras installed for use in our patrol cars. The new cameras are technologically advanced and will enhance our patrol division and obviously will allow for review of incidents and public interaction. The body worn cameras have been one of the most beneficial programs for our officers and for the public as well.

CI Division Report for June 2026 Board Meeting

5/21/2026 through 6/18/2026

Since May 21, 2026, WMTPD Criminal Investigations has taken on 63 new case assignments: 4 PICS investigations, 1 ChildLine Referral case for an alleged sexual assault of a juvenile, a drug delivery resulting in death (overdose) investigation, an assist to US Army CID and the US Capitol Police to locate and interview a subject posting online threats to a government official, 2 investigations into alleged possession/distribution of Child Sexual Abuse Material, and a widely expanded investigation into the theft and subsequent unauthorized use of EZ-Pass transponders from a trucking company within the Township that will now have to be split into 54 separate cases with a total loss in the area of a half million dollars.

During the same time frame, our office has formally closed out 6 cases: all 4 of the PICS cases listed above, the assist to other Police Department listed above, and the aggravated assault against the nurse at UPMC Memorial Hospital listed in last month's report.

In addition to the above, it is worth noting that, at the Chief's request, Det. Fink and I devoted time to developing a design proposal for new badges for the Department and I spent several days up-fitting the Department's new patrol rifles to get them ready to be put into service.
