Police Chief's Report for November

November 13th, 2025

Dear Board of Supervisors, Manager and staff.

For the month of October, the officers handled 469 incidents as well as 100 vehicle crashes. Officers conducted 262 traffic stops and issued 144 traffic citations. The department made 10 felony arrests, 50 misdemeanor arrests, 7 summary nontraffic arrests and 9 juvenile petition(s) were also filed.

Officer Zach Werner is now off field training and on his own on patrol. Officer Werner provides a vast amount of experience to our patrol division. Having multiple years of previous experience, Werner brings a lot to the table for the department as well as an additional patrol officer to add to our ranks. I am looking forward to seeing his progress and he is an asset to our agency.

CI Division Report for November 2025 Board Meeting 10/16/2025 through 11/6/2025

Since October 16, 2025, WMTPD Criminal Investigations has taken on 7 new case assignments: 3 ChildLine Referral cases for physical or sexual abuse of a child or general child endangerment, 1 investigation into alleged abuse of a care-dependent adult, a fraud/identity theft case, a sexual assault involving adult victim and suspect, and a terroristic threats investigation.

During the same time frame, our office has formally closed out 9 cases: the terroristic threats case listed above, 4 ChildLine Referral investigations into physical/sexual abuse of children, an assault case involving adults, 2 rape/sexual assault investigations involving adult victims, an elder abuse/exploitation case reported in September.
